



don Josip Mužić, Croatian priest

Don Josip Mužić, sin Ivana i Vlaste, **rođen je 28. 4. 1961.** u Splitu gdje je završio i osnovnu školu. U Rimu završava gimnaziju i upisuje se na sveučilište La Sapienza gdje na fakultetu filozofije diplomira s najvišim ocjenama. Na papinskom sveučilištu Lateranum postiže bakalaureat iz teologije, a na Ateneu Antonianum postiže doktorat iz filozofije (*summa cum laude*). Specijalizaciju iz teologije pohađao je u Španjolskoj na Navarskom sveučilištu gdje je nakon magisterija obranio i doktorat koncem 1993., također *summa cum laude*.

Od 1995. stalno je zaposlen i **predaje na KBF-u Sveučilišta u Splitu razne kolegije**, a isto tako i na drugim fakultetima. U zvanje redovitog profesora iz znanstvenog područja filozofije izabran je 2013. Pročelnikom katedre filozofije KBF-a Sveučilišta u Splitu biran je više puta. Na istom fakultetu član je iše povjerenstava, voditelj poslijediplomskog studija i član uredništva časopisa *Crkva u svijetu*.

Zaređen je za svećenika 1992. u Rimu od Svetoga Oca Ivana Pavla II.

Pastoralno djeluje kao upravitelj crkve sv. Filipa Nerija i dušebrižnik. Posljednjih deset godina ima mjesečnu emisiju **Sjaj istine na Radio Mariji** i daje duhovnu **asistenciju bolesničkom hodočašću u Lurd**. Organizirao je i vodio **više pokorničkih hodočašća pješke** i to: Solin-Rama; Solin-Marija Bistrica; Split-Rim; Split-Kotor. Od 2003. barem jednom godišnje vodi **susrete za bračne parove i djecu**. Autor je sljedećih objavljenih djela: *Filozofska metodologija*, *Ugađanje duše*. *Priručnik za ispitivanje savjesti* i *Rat protiv čovjeka*.

Član je Matice Hrvatske, Hrvatskog filozofskog društva te Hrvatskog bioetičkog društva. Dobitnik je više priznanja za humanitarno djelovanje. Uvršten je u prestižno izdanje američkog biografskog instituta (ABI) *Five Hundred Leaders of Influence* (1996.) i dobitnik je međunarodnog priznanja *Twentieth Century Achivment Award* (1995.).

Don Josip Mužić, son of Ivan and Vlasta, was born on the 28th of April, 1961, in Split, where he also finished elementary school. He finished high school in Rome and enrolled into Sapienza University where he graduated from the Faculty of Philosophy with the highest grades. He received a bachelor's degree in theology from the Pontifical

Lateran University and a PhD in philosophy (*summa cum laude*) from Athenaeum Antonianum. He specialised in theology in Spain at the University of Navarra where he received a master's degree and a PhD later in 1993, also with *summa cum laude*. Since 1995, he has been employed and has given various courses at the Catholic Faculty of Theology of the University of Split, as well as at other faculties. He was elected full professor for the scientific field of philosophy in 2013. He has been elected head of the Department of Philosophy at the University of Split for several times. He has been a member of various commissions at the same faculty, head of postgraduate studies and a member of the editorial office of the magazine 'Church in the world'. He was ordained as a priest in 1992 in Rome by the Holy Father John Paul II. He acts pastorally as head of the church of St Philip Neri and as chaplain. For the last ten years he has aired a monthly show called 'The Splendour of Truth' on Radio Mary and provided spiritual assistance at pilgrimages of the sick to Lourdes. He has organised and led several pilgrimages on foot which included following routes: Solin - Rama; Solin - Marija Bistrica; Split - Rome; Split - Kotor. Since 2003 he has led retreats for married couples and children at least once a year. He is the author of the following published works: *Philosophical Methodology*, *The Tuning of the Soul*, *A Manual for the Examination of Conscience*, and *War against Man*. He is a member of Matica hrvatska, the Croatian Philosophical Society, and the Croatian Bioethics Society. He has received many recognitions for his humanitarian involvement. He was included in the prestigious edition of the American Biographical Institute (ABI) called *Five Hundred Leaders of Influence* (1996) and was the winner of the international recognition *Twentieth Century Achievement Award* (1995).
